Pinned Q&A's

Using a variety of Poll Everywhere activities throughout your lecture slides can help maintain student attention and engagement. You can also insert a [Pinned Q&A](#) into the slide deck so students can submit questions at any time during the class. Before class ends, dedicate some time to going through these submitted questions so that the whole class can see the answers.

Asynchronous Activities

Poll Everywhere is not just a synchronous tool, activity types such as [Surveys](#), [Rankings](#) and [Pinned Q&A's](#) allow for plenty of asynchronous collaboration and can help you ensure everyone is on the same page. For example, you can send out a survey after class to see how students are doing, and ensure they are confident with the class material.

Think-Pair-Share

Think-Pair-Share is a unique classroom activity to check on the students' understanding of the course material. Students are paired up, prompted a question and are then tasked to think through the question together and provide their answer to the class. You can use [Open-ended activities](#) to give students a platform to submit their answers once they are finished. Then, take some time to go over all of the answers with the class.

Pulse Surveys

Pulse Surveys are a way to check on students throughout the semester, rather than just the beginning and end of the semester. [Surveys](#) allow you to collect student feedback on the course while also giving you insight into student's progress and experience. Remember, Surveys do not have to be presented live, they can also be emailed to students to [complete asynchronously](#).

Entry & Exit Tickets

Entry and exit tickets are quick pop quizzes that you give either before or at the end of the lecture. These do not necessarily need to have a grade associated, but instead can be a quick check in on the students' knowledge. This activity will help you understand how the students are taking in the course material and help you direct how the class should go.
